The key factor in proving delay, disruption and loss is the quality of the records. An explanation will be given of the various records needed and how to use them to identify critical and other delays together with a detailed explanation of the required content of those records. There will also be an explanation of the various likely heads of claim and the varying nature of proof required. Attendees will gain an understanding of the records they need to keep in order to prove delay and loss.
