NEC provides for prospective quotation assessments, often prior to the work being carried out, to achieve time and cost predictability.

Our experience of dispute resolution proceedings has identified that the parties' failures to adhere to the prescribed timescales of NEC, or a fundamental misunderstanding of the provisions themselves, often leads to conflict.

In view of the above, our seminar will consider some of the issues surrounding compensation events:

- Notifying early warnings and compensation events
- The use of assumptions
- Assessing Defined Costs and Disallowed costs
- Assessment of compensation events using the 'dividing line'
- Revision of compensation event quotations when forecasts later turn out to be wrong
- Assessing delay to planned Completion

During the seminar we will also review some of the recent changes brought about by NEC4. Described as an evolution not a revolution, the amendments to certain clauses will result in a significant effect on the assessment of compensation events.
