Panel discussion and Q&A, followed by networking and drinks

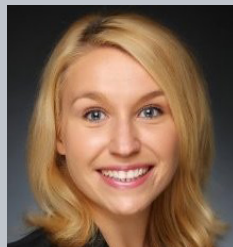
